### **3. Reasons for Hope for 2022**

Climate crises are not going to diminish in 2022, but there is hope for changes that may address these crises.

- *At the International Level:* During the Glasgow Conference of Parties (COP26) of the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change, a number of side agreements on coal, methane, deforestation, fossil fuel subsidies, fossil fuel production and finance were reached. These side agreements are described in detail [on our website here](#). We suggest that you take the actions proposed in the side agreement [news](#), which would encourage the Biden Administration to join those agreements where appropriate.
- *At the National Level:* The Build Back Better bill (BBBB) is still pending as we send this newsletter, and we urge you to send messages in support to members of Congress. There is a description of the bill with proposed actions [here](#).
- *At the State Level:* The Environmental Priorities Coalition has listed a number of bills coming up in 2022 that address climate change. When these bills are introduced in January, you can follow their progress in the [legislature](#). You can find a list [here](#).
