Then ask your family, friends, and groups to sign our petition to our U.S. Senators Patty Murray and Maria Cantwell and U.S. Representatives to endorse, advocate for, and vote for <u>H.</u> <u>Con. Res. 37</u> and <u>S. Con. Res. 9</u>, to demand President Biden declare a climate emergency, stop all new fossil fuel projects, and speed up the transition to clean energy and better protections for our environment now.
